Looking after the 7th Court

So that we look after the 7th court and to minimise the artificial clay being transferred to other areas of the club we ask you to adhere to the following:

- Do not play in very wet conditions.
- Tennis shoes to be worn on the court.
- Clean your shoes before and after playing to avoid contamination of the tennis court surfaces.
- Drag the provided mat side to side across the whole court after playing.
- Balls that fall between the fence and the building will be collected by ground staff at a later date. Do **NOT** try to remove them from within the court.
- Balls that fall beyond the fence at either end of the court can be collected via the gates.
