



Fire

This is a reminder that if you come across a fire at the club, please shout "**FIRE**" as loud as possible to alert other people in the club and leave the premises as soon as possible.

In the clubhouse we have a water fire extinguisher, CO2 Fire extinguisher and a fire blanket. The fire extinguishers are serviced annually. You are not expected to use the fire extinguishers. - Staff, Coaches and Volunteers. All our level 2 coaches and above are LTA Accredited coaches and relevant roles within the club have completed a satisfactory criminal record check.
- Procedure. Safeguarding risks are considered when running activities and events at the club.

Tennis Balls

This is a reminder that tennis balls get changed **three times a week** at the club- Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday. When they are first put out on the rack there is enough for 4 balls per court.
